## Introduction



This is a certificated training program to provide nominated assessors with the necessary knowledge and skills to be a competent assessor. The course is designed in 2 parts where the participant will first attend a 3 day workshop to gain the knowledge in assessment techniques. The second part of the program requires the participant to conduct live assessment for two candidates for two units.

## Learning Outcome

By the end of the program the candidate will be certified as a BTEC Assessor with a Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the work environment. During the program they will gain the knowledge and skills to coach and assess candidates consistently and effectively. This is a competence based program hence the participants are required to demonstrate their ability to conduct competence Assessment for at least two live candidates.

## Program Designed For

Supervisors who have the responsibility to evaluate candidates in a competence assured environment, where assessment is conducted on the candidates evidence portfolio.
